

Greetings HPS friends and family:

Harmony Public Schools will continue to offer free (no cost) breakfast meals and lunch meals for all children ages 18 and under as well as students under 21 who are currently enrolled in a school and are identified as mentally or physically disabled during the month of June. Free breakfast and lunch will be available daily for students attending classes at the school. Meals will be available for pick up at all campuses for breakfast and then again for lunch. Please check the campus website, social media or contact the campus directly regarding the specific dates and times (this information differs per campus due to the campus' summer school schedule). Meal pick-up is open to our students, their siblings, and the community. Parents wishing to pick up a meal bag without children present will need to present one of the following to verify guardianship:

- **Individual student report cards**
- **Attendance record from parent portal of a school website**
- **Birth certificate**
- **Official letter/email from facility or school listing children enrolled**
- **Other official ID cards (for example, IDs issued by a child care facility)**

In regards to the current meal box pick-ups, the last day for meal box pickup will be **Thursday, May 27th from 3:00pm-4:00pm** at the below sites; this will be a 7-day meal box.

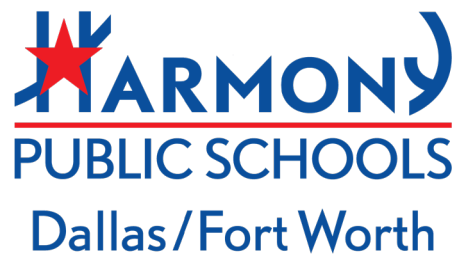

Las Escuelas Públicas de Harmony continuarán ofreciendo desayunos y almuerzos gratuitos (sin costo) para todos los niños menores de 18 años, así como para los estudiantes menores de 21 que están actualmente inscritos en una escuela y están identificados como discapacitados mental o físicamente durante el mes de junio. . El desayuno y el almuerzo gratuitos estarán disponibles todos los días para los estudiantes que asistan a clases en la escuela. Las comidas estarán disponibles para recoger en todos los campus para el desayuno y luego nuevamente para el almuerzo.
